What will we be doing?

Saturday, June 11 – Leave Columbus, OH. Arrive in Washington DC. Orientation.

Sunday, June 12 – Worship with local church. Community Interaction/Ministry.

Monday-Wednesday, June 13-15 – Ministry projects.

Thursday, June 16 – Ministry and Fun day.

Friday, June 17 – Leave in the morning and arrive in Indianapolis, IN.

Saturday, June 18 – Leave Indianapolis, IN. Arrive at Fee Fee.

What does the cost cover?

- Lodging (local school, church, or college dorm facility)
- All meals on the trip
- Project preparation and program materials
- T-shirt for each participant
- Experienced leadership at projects
- Fun day activities
