re you living in submission to Your king? This Sunday we continue our series "The Kingdom". At the start of the series we saw that we are living in the Kingdom of God now. So does your life reflect that you are living for your king? If you've been following along in our Bible reading plan you read some other parables of Jesus about the kingdom of God in Matthew 13:44-46. In these two short parables Jesus claims that the kingdom of God is worth giving up everything to attain. He's pointing to the incomparable worth of being a part of the kingdom of God. He's also pointing to the call of those who are followers of Christ to be willing to give up everything for God's glory. Does that describe the value you place on the kingdom?
