In addition, we will be having a special combined study for all adults for the first six weeks of the fall. We will be diving deeper into evangelism and the 3 Circles technique for sharing your faith. We will drill down into how to turn everyday conversations into gospel conversations. It is going to be a great study and I would encourage you to join us. We want to learn how to share our faith without fear.

Finally, on that note, I hope you have been challenged by the 3 Circles series thus far. The personal testimonies have been moving, and I'm praying that this tool will be a game-changer in our evangelistic endeavors. I wanted to close by sharing the 3 Circles script, and encourage you to practice walking through this method of sharing our faith.

3 Circles Script: God has a design for every area of our lives—our families, marriages, money, sex life, work life and just plain life. God designed us to be in relationship with Him, but we have all departed from that design. The Bible calls this sin. We're born with a sinful nature so sin comes naturally to us. There is no one who gets it right all of the time. We all sin and fall short of God's perfect design (Romans 3:23). This sin leaves us in brokenness. Brokenness is easy for most of us to understand. It feels like broken relationships, addiction, depression, discouragement, quilt and shame. We all want out of brokenness, so we try to fix it (squiggly lines out of brokenness). We medicate it with drugs or numb it with alcohol. We strive to be better people, hoping that somehow, someway, our good will outweigh our bad. We look for ways to alleviate our pain. When we do that, we just get more and more broken. This feels like a bad thing, but in many ways brokenness is a good thing because it's the way God gets our attention. When we feel broken on the inside and everything's all messed up, we know something needs to change. The Bible word for change is repent. Brokenness is what gets us ready to try God's solution, which is to repent and believe the gospel. The change we really need comes from
